## **Parent Guidelines**


- 1. Please respect that your child is there to compete and has a job to do. Try not to distract them from their tasks. They will come and say "hello and thank you" when they can.
- 2. Only Coaches and Coxswains may go to the coxswains meeting.
- 3. Only Coaches and Athletes are allowed on the dock and only if you are docking a crew.
- 4. BOOTS!! Lake Waramaug is very mucky!! We cannot stress this enough!! DO NOT WEAR NICE SHOES or PANTS!! We have had moms lose dress shoes or sandals as they sink into a foot of mud!!!

## **Parking Instructions**

- There will be State Police, Washington Police and DEEP Conservation Police and Park Officials located throughout the State Park. If they ask you to do something, please comply.
- Traffic will be one-way around the lake. Washington Police will be directing traffic.
- There is to be no parking along the road unless the police deem it necessary, which is usually the case for this regatta. Please just follow their directions.

- There will be a shuttle bus again this year. There are 3 mini school buses. They will pick up and drop off spectators along the lake. It will go up around the park and golf course and back to the start. Please look for Shuttle Bus signs. Also, if you are walking on the road, please stay out of the way of traffic. ROWERS ARE NOT TO GET ON THE SHUTTLE BUS!!
- The Campgrounds are OFF LIMITS. NO ONE is to go into the campground for ANY reason!! Please help me out and follow this request by the park rangers.
- The finish line area is next to our tent. I will be there all day. Please do not come into the finish line area to talk. It is for officials only.
- There will be port-o-lets located throughout the park. I recommend bringing extra toilet paper. Do not use any of the bathrooms at the park
- Garbage needs to be placed in the dumpsters up where the buses park or the dumpsters near the finish line. If they are full, we need to take our garbage home with us.
- We will be selling shirts at the regatta. Shirts are \$25.00. Proceeds help to fund the regatta.
- Also, there will be State Police and DEEP Police please follow all their directions and be kind and courteous
- Please make sure that you take all your garbage and place it in the dumpsters by the bus area. If the dumpster is full you need to take it home.
- No Drones, Hammocks, Horns or other noise makers are allowed per the DEEP Permit
