
Please read the following from the Kent Coach regarding parking and areas that are open or closed to guests.

#### **Parking Instructions**

- Please be advised that traffic will be one-way and there will be quite a few police in the area.
- DRONES and Hammocks are not permitted
- Cell service: There is very limited (if any) cell service at the regatta site.

- Also, there will be State Police and DEEP Police please follow all their directions and be kind and courteous. Do not go near the Park Ranger Office.
- Please make sure that you take all your garbage and place it in the dumpsters by the bus area. If the dumpster is full you need to take it home.
- Please only use the port-o-lets. Do not use any of the bathrooms at the park. You may want to bring your own roll of toilet paper
- The campground is off limits.
